Dr Sharon Kalsy is a clinical psychologist with 20 years' experience of working with adults with complex mental health, clinical health, forensic and cognitive difficulties. She has worked with adolescent sex offenders in the prison service and in low, medium and maximum-security hospitals, adults with brain injuries which have resulted in mood and behavioural changes. HIV positive adults who have been sexually abused or who have sexual offended, child protection issues relating to HIV positive pregnant women and sexually active children, and she has assessed capacity in people with learning and developmental difficulties who engage in risk taking behaviours.

Dr Kalsy runs a private clinic offering therapy to individuals, couples and groups to help manage depression, anxiety, life changes, psychological trauma, bereavement and stress management. She also conducts fitness to work insurance cases and medicolegal assessments to examine appropriateness for deportation in asylum seekers. She also assesses the impact of cognitive motor impairment on criminal behaviour.

Dr Kalsey developed the HIV and Sexual Health Psychology Service to increase access and treatment pathways for HIV+ asylum seekers, sexually active children, sexual dysfunction patients, and survivors of sexual abuse. I led a large caseload of clients and offered individual couples-based, family and group therapy solution focussed interventions using CBT, motivational interviewing, narrative therapy, mindfulness and systemic psychotherapy.
