He worked for 13 years as a clinical psychologist in NHS forensic services, including as Head of Psychology for South London and Maudsley (SLAM) forensic services. He brings his specialist training and forensic experience to the assessment of risk within families, adult relationships and the parent-child interaction. He assesses a broad range of risk including violence, domestic violence, sexual abuse and non-accidental injury.
