Dr Anna Markham is a Forensic Psychologist specialising in the assessment and treatment of children and their families. Her work involves the assessment of complex developmental and attachment trauma and how this contributes to severe behavioural difficulty and offending in children and adolescents. She has specialist training and experience in working with adolescents at risk of sexually harmful behaviours. She undertakes multi-systemic interventions with families and has studied the outcomes of these interventions and a family's capacity for change.

- Dr Markham assesses children and adults of all ages at risk of developmental harm.
- She undertakes specialist forensic risk assessments of parents and their families who are at risk of developmental harm has specialist training and experience across all aspects of parental capacity and risk including neglect, emotional harm, violence, domestic violence, sexual violence and abuse.
- She specialises in the assessment of child and adolescent offending and sexual risk.
- She works with children and adolescents with a broad range of mental health and personality difficulties and the risks that they pose to themselves and others.
