Dr Ana Reis is a clinical psychologist specialising in working with children and adults with complex psychological and cognitive problems. She has worked extensively with children at risk and provides specialist family and parental risk assessments for the family courts. She has also worked in child and adolescent mental health teams and has an in-depth knowledge of mental health disorders in children and the impact of familial problems. Dr Ana Reis specialised in working with adults with Personality Disorders. She worked in a Complex Needs Services providing intensive psychotherapy to adults with personality problems and supervised criminal/offending cases from other NHS and forensic services. Dr Reis carries out different assessments on personality, trauma, attachment, abuse, aggression/offending behaviour and mental capacity. She also assesses children's placements, family dynamics and parenting capacity. She designed a service for the Cambridge University Hospitals for children with brain tumours and can provide cognitive assessments, to assess cases of negligence and the liaison between neuropsychology and mental health.
