Dr Grieve's research on PTSD has been presented at the annual conference for the Association of Personal Injury Lawyers. He has completed private clinical and medico-legal reports for large public sector organisations. He has been commissioned to provide clinical reports for large financial institutions as part of employee return to work proceedings.

Dr Grieve has extensive experience of assessing adults with a wide range of mental health problems by psychometric objective assessments and clinical interview. Dr Grieve currently works for the Older Adults Service in the NHS.
