Dr Rees' clinical work over the past 40+ years has been largely within adult mental health and behavioural medicine. He has particular expertise in the assessment and treatment of anxiety based disorders, including PTSD, and mood disorders. His principal research interest is in work related stress and emotional disorders.

Dr Rees has been carrying out medico-legal assessments on behalf of both claimants and defendants for more than thirty five years. He is listed in the British Psychological Society's Directory of Expert Witnesses. Approximately 80% of his work is for claimants, 15% joint and 5% for defendants. Whilst the majority of his work is concerned with road traffic and other accidents and CICA claims, he has provided a substantial number of reports for claimants in clinical negligence cases.
