I am a Consultant Paediatric Neuropsychologist and Head of Neuropsychology at University Hospitals Bristol NHS Trust. I have been employed within Neurosciences in Bristol since 2005 and was appointed as Head of Department in 2006. Prior to my current appointment I worked as a Clinical Neuropsychologist at several tertiary neuroscience centres in the UK. My current clinical role involves the assessment and management of children with neurological disorders, including children who have suffered an acquired insult such as a traumatic brain injury. My academic qualifications are D.Clin.Psychol. (Leeds), PhD (Warwick) and MA (Cantab). I am a Chartered Clinical Psychologist (C.Psychol) and a Practitioner Full Member of the Division of Neuropsychology of the British Psychological Society. I am also a Fellow of the British Psychological Society (FBPsS). I am an Honorary Professor in Psychology at the University of Bristol.

I have published numerous studies in scientific journals, and regularly present at international conferences on aspects of acquired brain injury in childhood. I contribute to a range of teaching programmes in child neuropsychology including the BPS Division of Neuropsychology programmes, University College London, Royal Holloway and Bedford College, and the Universities of Bristol and Cardiff. I was appointed inaugural Chair of the Faculty of Paediatric Neuropsychology in 2011.

In 2006, I was appointed Chief Assessor in Neuropsychology for the British Psychological Society and in 2012, Chair of the Clinical Neuropsychology Qualifications Board. I have been appointed as external examiner at the University of Newcastle, University of Nottingham, and most recently at University College London. I have examined numerous PhDs, DClinPsychol and MSc thesis. I am Clinical Practice Director of the Bristol Diploma course in Clinical Neuropsychology.

I maintained an interest in clinical and research aspects of paediatric neuropsychology since completing my first degree at Cambridge University in 1992. My subsequent PhD research was aimed at identifying aspects of a specific cognitive phenotype in infants with a neurodevelopmental disorder. Having completed this research, I undertook a Doctorate in Clinical Psychology and my training included both clinical experience and research related to paediatric neuropsychology. My doctoral research project was aimed at developing a new measure of neuropsychological functioning appropriate for use with young children. My clinical training incorporated specialist training at tertiary neuropsychology services in London.

After finishing clinical training, I worked for 2 years in a specialist paediatric neuropsychology service at Great Ormond Street Hospital in London, providing a specialist neuropsychological assessment service to children with epilepsy and other developmental and acquired neurological problems. In 2014, I spent time working with colleagues at the Children's National Hospital in Washington DC developing skills in functional imaging in paediatric epilepsy.



As a Clinical Lecturer, I have been actively engaged in research, clinical practice and supervision in the area of paediatric neuropsychology. I have numerous published papers, have secured a number of grants and currently offer specialist supervision and training to doctoral students, research assistants, clinical trainees and qualified clinical psychologists. I frequently accept instructions for medico legal work on both clinical negligence and personal injury claims. I accept 30 new instructions per year with 80% being from claimant's solicitors. I have undertaken recent training organized by Bond Solon / AChiPP in medico-legal practice, court skills and reporting.
