#### The Autism Assessment Service and Discover Difference

My work as lead clinician on the autism and ADHD assessment pathways. This involves completing informant-based interview (e.g., ADI-R) or ADOS assessments, information gathering from schools, interpretation of Qb test and cognitive assessment results. I chair MDT meetings to support diagnostic conclusion, provided in-depth feedback to clients and a neuroaffirmative assessment report. I have also developed competence in interpretation of the Qb Test reports. I closely liaise with educational provisions at assessment and post-diagnostic stage, including recommendations of adjustments. I routinely complete risk assessments and support other staff in risk management practices.

## Jun 2021 – Jul 2023 Senior Clinical Psychologist

## Betsi Cadwaladr NHS Health Board, Wrexham Maelor Hospital

Provided specialist autism and ADHD assessments and post-diagnostic support to young people and their families. The role required routine completion of cognitive assessments to aid differential diagnoses. I led the development of a regional, stepped-care ARFID treatment pathway. To address the common comorbidity of neurodevelopmental and developmental trauma difficulties, I provided ongoing training and consultation to the MDT around providing trauma-informed support to families and wider agencies. I provided supervision and teaching to junior psychologists.

Clerkin Psychology provided agency contracts to North Wales Tier 3 CAMHS.
