Dr McDowell has over 15 years of experience working as an educational and clinical psychologist with adults, children, families in Local Authorities and for the courts. She has expertise in child development including cognitive, linguistic, sensory, physical, social, behavioural and emotional difficulties. She specialises in working with children and young people whose development is either delayed or disordered.

FAMILY COURT EXPERTISE

- Dr McDowell regularly reports to Local Authorities and the Family Courts.
- Comprehensive assessments of children and young people and their families including full psychological and cognitive assessment of children and young people.
- Assessment of attachment relationships including: the welfare of, and impact on, the child and young person in parenting breakdown and, the assessment of risk in cases where parents are having emotional difficulties in parenting their children and the parent-child relationship is starting to break down.
- Assessments of parental personality, mental health difficulties and the impact this has on their parenting capacity.
- The nature of a child's attachment and sibling relationships and the impact of separation, contact and loss.
- Placement needs of children following a Care Order including whether siblings should be placed together or separately and the nature and extent of contact with the birth family.
