I work in the Waltham Forest borough looking after patients who are acutely unwell or in crisis and requiring urgent psychiatric input. I review their needs, provide recommend the necessary support, and consider the need to initiate, modify or stop psychotropic medications. I also assess the need to involve other services to help in the care of patients. I work in a multidisciplinary team of different professionals (Psychiatrists, mental health nurses, psychologists, occupational therapists and support workers) and we meet daily to discuss every patient seen and provide the appropriate support and care required, following the BioPsychoSocial model of care and also looking after the physical as well as the mental health.

January – April 2020 Specialty Doctor, Male PICU (Bearsted Ward) at Cygnet Hospital Maidstone

I am tasked with looking after all the patients on the male PICU ward. I review patients upon admission to the unit by taking adequate history including collateral history and retrieving previous past medical record from their GP and local mental health teams; regularly reviewing patients' mental states and risks, discussing care plan and management with the MDT; completing the risk assessment, physical examination, reviewing the psychotropics and physical health medications and escalating to senior colleagues when required. I am able to identify my limits and consult with RCs as appropriate.
